

Section 7.

Registration of Boilers:

With an amendment of the Act the old inspection procedure for registration of boilers now the Boilers will be examined by the Inspector of Boilers for registration has to rely on the documents of manufacture such as

- a) Approval of drawing of the boilers and boilers components by the inspecting authority.
- b) Inspection during manufacturer by the inspecting authority
- c) The design of the Boiler and the pressure alongwith the boiler is to be operated alongwith all other related documents regarding materials used, prescribed certificates approved by the inspecting authority, tubes and pipes in form II of IBR. The owner has to submit all other documents required for registration of the boilers as is necessary under the provisions of the Act and Regulations.

The inspector has to only see as to whether the boiler has been received in safe condition and has not suffered any damage during the transit.

Section 8.

Renewal of Certificate of Operation :

The procedure for renewal of operational certificate has been reviewed and the following changes have been incorporated:-

Whenever the words inspector has appeared it is to be changed with Competent Persons for inspection of boilers during use.

- i) The original provision for operational certificate for 12 months has been changed in order to consider the use of latest technology during the manufacturer and operation and maintenance of boilers. Now the operation certificate will be issued by the competent person for a period depending upon the maintenance policy of the management of the user/owner and not necessarily be for 12 months. The condition of the boiler has to be seen before granting any certificate of operations and shall be as per the prescribed procedure in the regulations.
- ii) The owner / user has to appoint a competent person for inspection of his boilers at least one month before the expiry of his operation certificate under the conditions which has been enumerated under the section 8 of the Indian Boilers Act.
- iii) The competent person shall inspect the boilers in line with the see all provisions enumerated in Regulation 375, 376, 377, 378, 379, 390, 391, 391A and 392 of the Indian Boiler regulations 1950. He shall suggest necessary repairs to bring the boiler in line with requirements of IBR 1950. A competent person shall have to abide by the requirements of the section 8 of the Act and the Indian Boilers Resolution 1950. Therefore, the regulations providing for inspection of boilers need to be changed by the board.
